Muskegon Heights Public School Academy System

Pursuant to Applicable Law and the Terms and Conditions of this Contract, including Section 6.5, the Muskegon Heights Public School Academy System ("System") shall properly administer the academic assessments identified in this schedule in accordance with the testing windows identified in the Master Calendar of Reporting Requirements, annually issued by the District, or RTAB acting on the District's behalf, and ensure that the individuals involved with the testing are properly trained and adhere to the ethical standards and testing procedures associated with each assessment.

The System shall allow the District, or the RTAB acting on the District's behalf, to have access to the System's Student/School Data Applications through the Center for Educational Performance and Information and to the electronic reporting systems administered by the Michigan Department of Education to access the System's Michigan Test of Student Educational Progress (M-STEP), PSAT, MME and other state assessment results, as applicable. The System shall participate in voluntary interim assessments as they become available from the Michigan Department of Education and any successor assessments required by the State of Michigan.
