MUSKEGON HEIGHTS DEDICATES GYM, MEDIA CENTER

The Muskegon Heights Public Schools will honor the memory of one its most popular and longest serving superintendents by dedicating the Muskegon Heights High School gymnasium in his honor. At the same time, another longtime supporter of the Muskegon Heights Public Schools will have the high school media center dedicated in his name.

The contributions of the late John E. Sydnor, MHPS superintendent for over 20 years, and the late Charles M. Waugh, a prominent local attorney and former Muskegon Heights Board of Education member, will be celebrated at dedication ceremonies to be held prior to the Muskegon Heights vs. Inkster varsity basketball game on Saturday, February 17 at the high school, 2441 Sanford Street, in Muskegon Heights.

The celebration will also include a private reception in the high school media center for family, friends and colleagues on Saturday afternoon.

The reception, to be held from 4:00 p.m. to 5:30 p.m., will include a number of personal tributes, the showing of a special video-biography, musical performances and refreshments.
