

2. ACADEMIC SUMMARY

History of Muskegon Heights Public School Charter Creation

- * The District's cumulative General Fund (GF) deficit increased by 102 percent in one year (from \$4.2 million to \$8.5 million), and was expected to be \$9.4 million by the end of the 2012 fiscal year.
- * The District's year-end GF balances had been negative since 2006.
- * The District's pupil enrollment had decreased by more than 52 percent since 2006 to 2012 (from 2,142 to 1,408).

History of Muskegon Heights Public School Charter Creation

- The establishment of a new public school academy (charter) system to provide educational services to students in the District.
- → On May 1, 2014, Dr. Weatherspoon released a Request for Proposals (RFP) seeking an operator for the newly formed Muskegon Heights Public School Academy System.
- → On July 9, 2012, Dr. Weatherspoon signed an order establishing a contract between the former district and the Muskegon Heights Public School Academy System as a means to provide education for the students of Muskegon Heights.
- ⇒ Implemented management agreement between the Muskegon Heights Public School Academy and Mosaica Education Inc. (MEI) was signed, declaring that MEI would become the PSA's Education Service Provider (ESP).

History of Muskegon Heights Public School Charter Creation

- Contract Modified in 2014 to create a new self-managed model.
- ⇒ Order 2014-6 enabled the Academy to contract for all services necessary to operate the Public School Academy.
- ⇒ Following that order, MHPSA contracted with the following:
 - Alena Zachery Ross Superintendent of Schools
 - Muskegon Area Intermediate School District Financial Services
 - Access Point Human Resources and Payroll
