Muskegon Heights Public School Academy System to hold a public forum and unity meeting on Monday, July 16

Muskegon Heights, Mich. — Emergency Manager Dr. Donald Weatherspoon, the Board of Directors of the Muskegon Heights Public School Academy System, and representatives of Mosaica Education will hold a public forum and unity meeting at **5:30 p.m.** on Monday, July 16 in the Waters Performing Arts Center at the **Muskegon Heights High School**. This will be the first public forum since Dr. Weatherspoon and the newly appointed System board selected Mosaica Education to be the education provider for the new charter system scheduled to open this fall.
